

CSTE Update to Standardized Surveillance Case Definition for Campylobacteriosis

- **Expanded case ascertainment criteria:**

- Clinically compatible illness is no longer required to trigger reporting.
- Symptomatic individuals epidemiologically linked to a **confirmed or probable** case should now be reported.

- **Clarified case classification:**

- Laboratory evidence alone may be used to classify cases as confirmed or probable.

- **Extended case enumeration period:**

- The timeframe for distinguishing a new case has increased from **30 days to 90 days**.
