No volunteers for subcommittee to work on AAR. We reviewed file from feedback forms from College of Public Health completed by attendees at last fall's FSE. Will use controllers' messages. Discussed flow of patients planned by CoPH, Sign-In Sheet was outside, and many players missed documenting their attendance. Sarah was on blood collection station, said that patients had no direction as to where to go and when they would receive results (should have been exit station). LIS system was used but patient data entry not well planned. Patients were to complete via QR site, was not developed enough with instructions. Patient did receive labels for labeling collection devices. Instructions needed as to where patient should go. Urine collection was not represented so will follow up later. Exit station should have been manned by county HD, answered questions on results options, no certificates of attendance were handed out. The group reviewed photo's taken from FSE. Not as well prepared as last several years. Conclusion boiled down to setup. This year, we could not set up the day before and it was chaos to set up the hour before. Therefore, this provides material for a TTX in 2023, possibly April.
Have not worked on.
Other drills, exercises, tabletops? Lakeside did quarterly fire drill, but AAA did not recommend exiting building to meet outside. Reason is patients would need to be evacuated. Not possible during normal workday. Julie Knowlton joined to share active shooter. Maggie Summerfelt shared they are going through mock inspection.
